Georgia Genealogical Society Call for Lecture Proposals

April 28, 2012 Meeting

Georgia Genealogical Society and Augusta Genealogical Society members are invited to submit lecture proposals for the April 28, 2012 meeting to be held in Augusta, Georgia.

The meeting will include four one-hour lectures. In keeping with our theme "Clues to Finding Your Ancestors!," lecture proposals should address any of the following:

- Archives, genealogical and historical societies, libraries, and repositories in Georgia
- Family history writing and publishing
- Georgia research
- Immigration and emigration patterns
- Methodology and problem solving techniques
- New research methodologies, strategies, or techniques
- Photography and genealogy
- Proving or disproving family stories
- Record analysis
- Resources available in Georgia (cemeteries, church records, courthouse records, newspapers, military information, etc.)
- Successful research trip planning

Sessions are one hour including questions and answers. If selected as a lecturer, a handout, in PDF format not to exceed 4 pages, is due by April 13, 2012. These handouts will be distributed to all meeting participants.

Presenters may submit a maximum of two proposals. Proposals should include the following information:

- Speaker's full name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address
- Title of lecture
- Short description of the lecture (50 word maximum) for use in the program publicity
- Identification of audience level: beginner, intermediate, or advanced
- Outline or summary of lecture
- Audio visual requirements
- Brief speaker biography (150 word maximum) including a photograph
- Summary of recent speaker experience

All proposals must be received by February 15, 2012. Invitations and contracts will be sent by March 1, 2012. Speakers will receive an honorarium (\$150 per lecture), meeting registration, and lunch. GGS will not cover travel or hotel expenses for this meeting.
